
Welcome to our new newsletter!


One of the things we couldn't do without your donations is show our staff how much we appreciate them! This month we had a **Cougar Dash on September 18th**.

Donate to the Giving Tree!

The Giving Tree is one of our biggest fundraisers every year, and it is a super easy way to help our school earn money! We earned \$5400 from them last year and had the most points again of any school. Here's how it works:

<u>The Giving Tree</u> is a local non-profit that accepts donations from the community with the specific goal of using the proceeds to generate funds for local schools! Donating is simple. All you do is grab a paper bag or box, fill it with gently used home goods or toys, and drop it off at the giving tree (839 South Main St) any time.

We get **DOUBLE POINTS** for donations made on **Monday and Tuesday**. **Be sure to tell them your donation is for Wake Forest High School**. They accept donations Monday-Friday from 10:30-4:30. There is a list of allowed goods and donation instructions on the **DONATE** page of their website. You get points for every donation and points every time you shop, so don't forget to look around while you are there. They are the cutest boutique!

Our first **Triple Points Week will be Oct 14-19th** so start cleaning out those closets and bring your gently used items to the giving tree any day this week. Any donation all week will get us triple credit points! And you can donate more than once!



Staff and Club Grants

We are starting the year off right with staff grants already underway! Staff, don't forget to request a grant if you have needs for your classroom!

Our latest grant was for **Newspaper**. We provided newspaper passes to Ms Freeman's class to make the experience more authentic. Now the students are ready to start interviewing, each pass individualized with student names and class info. 
